**77.01 VOLUNTARY REGISTRATION.** Each resident of the City who is the owner of a bicycle may make application for registration thereof to the Police Chief, the duration of which registration shall extend for a two-year period, whereupon renewal of said application shall be due. If the bicycle complies with the provisions hereof, the Police Chief shall issue an identification plate, which shall be securely fastened to the bicycle described in the application. The Police Chief shall maintain a record of the name and address of the owner, a description of such bicycle by name or make, the frame number thereof, and the number of the identification sticker issued.

**77.02 CONDITION PRECEDENT.** All bicycles submitted for registration shall be equipped as provided in Chapter 76 of this Code of Ordinances, and the Police Chief shall refuse to register any bicycle found not to be so equipped or found to be in an unsafe mechanical condition.

**77.03 REGISTRATION FEE.** A fee of one dollar (\$1.00) shall be charged by the City for each bicycle registered.

**77.04 TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP.** Upon the sale or other transfer of a registered bicycle, the owner shall, upon proper application to the Police Department, transfer his or her identification plate to the new owner.

**77.05 REMOVAL OF IDENTIFICATION STICKER.** No person shall remove any identification sticker from a bicycle during the period for which issued except in the event a bicycle is dismantled for repair or otherwise and no longer used upon any street or public way in the City.

**77.06 ALTERATION OF SERIAL FRAME NUMBER.** It is unlawful for any person to willfully or maliciously remove, destroy, mutilate or alter the manufacturer's serial frame number on any bicycle owned by a resident of the City.

**77.07 ALTERATION OF REGISTRATION NUMBER STICKER.** It is unlawful for any person to remove, destroy, mutilate, or alter any registration number sticker during the period when such registration is operative.

**77.08 DUPLICATE REGISTRATION STICKERS.** In the event of loss by the owner of a registration sticker, a duplicate sticker may be obtained from the Police Chief upon application and the payment of twenty-five cents (25¢).

**77.09 PENALTY.** Unless another penalty is expressly provided by this chapter for any particular provision or section, any person violating any provision of this chapter or any rule or regulation adopted herein by reference shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days.
