COMMUNITY ROOMS

The Community Rooms may be reserved by Clive residents for private parties and functions. For fee and reservation information at City Hall or the Special Events Building at the Clive Aquatic Center, call the Parks and Recreation Department at 223-5246. Reservation deadline is 10 business days prior to the event.

SHELTER RESERVATIONS

Shelters at Linnan, Greenbelt, Campbell Recreation Area, and Country Club Glen may be reserved. Call the Parks and Recreation Department for fee and reservation information. Reservation deadline is 10 business days prior to the event.

BLOCK PARTIES

Return a completed form with deposit to the Parks and Recreation Department. A Clive fire engine may be available for display if requested. A 21-day advance notice is required.

HOME SAFETY CHECKS

Clive's Fire Department will do a free home safety inspection upon request. They will assist with any safety questions or concerns. Call the Fire Department for details at 223-1595. Minimum of a two-week advance notice is recommended.
