BEAN BAG LEAGUE RULES

Introduction

The City of Clive Parks and Recreation welcomes your team to our league. Please review the enclosed rules and materials with your teammates. The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to make changes to this document as necessary during the course of the season. Managers will be notified of any changes.

If you have any questions or suggestions, please feel free to call the Parks and Recreation Office at 223-5246.

Eligibility

1. All players must be 18 years of age prior to the start of league play.
2. All team rosters must be complete and fees must be paid at the Parks and Recreation Office before participating in the league.

Facilities/Equipment

It is imperative that all participants show respect and take care of Campbell Park, bags and boards.

1. Equipment Check Out:
 - ❖ Home team must check out the bags before their scheduled match at the concession stand.
 - ❖ Bags must be returned following your match.
 - ❖ Winning team must report the scores to concession stand staff. Clip boards available on site, (*i.e.* 4-1, 2-3, 5-0).
 - ❖ Failure to return the bags will result in a \$25 charge.

Inclement Weather

1. If there has been inclement weather, teams may call the "Weather Hotline" at 830-1234 between 4:00-4:30 p.m. to find out the status of their match.
2. If matches have been cancelled for the evening by Parks and Recreation, matches may not be played that evening. Any matches played on these days will not be recorded.

General Rules

1. Teammates must stand on opposite sides.
2. Each player will throw 4 bags per inning.
3. Players may throw from either side of the board. You must throw from the same position at the beginning of each inning.
4. Player's feet must remain behind the front of the board on the release of the bag.
5. The team that scores will throw first; if it's a tie the preceding team will throw again.
6. Teams will play a total of 5 games.
7. TIEBREAKER – In the event of identical league records, head-to-head competition will be used to determine the winner. If a tie remains, the team with the most total games won will be declared the winner.
8. No Baggos (bag cannot hit the ground first and roll onto the board).
9. One-hour time limit – if the one hour time limit is up, the team leading at that point will be the winner of that game.

Scoring

1. Hole-Ins = 3 points
2. On-the-Board = 1 point
3. In cancellation scoring, bags in-the-hole and on-the-board cancel each other out.
4. First team to 21 points is the winner.
5. NO PROFANITY.
6. HAVE FUN!

CAMPBELL RECREATION AREA PARK RULES

1. **Beer Rule:** Canned beer may be brought into the park.
2. **No-Smoking Rule:** Smoking is prohibited on playgrounds and in park shelters located on City property, including adjacent areas within 50 feet of playgrounds, park shelters, concessions stand, ballfields and sand volleyball courts. (In compliance with the Iowa Smokefree Air Act.)
3. All animals must be under control by owner and on a leash.
4. All litter must be disposed of in trash receptacles. Please be considerate!
5. Park curfew is 10:30 p.m.
