

An underground lawn irrigation permit application must be completed and returned to Clive Public Works for review and approval. An approved copy must be at the job site during installation. Please send to:

1. Only sprinkler heads and associated piping are allowed in the parking area between the sidewalk and the street. Sprinkler heads and associated piping shall not extend more than one foot (1') from the street side of the sidewalk. If there is not a sidewalk present no more than one foot (1') from the property line. All other associated system appurtenances shall remain on private property. Clive Code of Ordinance 7-1-17.
2. Property owners installing lawn irrigation appurtenances within the parking area do so at their own risk and without any right, title or interest in the parking or in the free use and enjoyment of the parking.
3. Property owners shall take notice of the fact that lawn irrigation system installations in the parking will be subject to damage or destruction at any time that the City or a person with a utility easement deems it necessary to enter upon the parking for construction, maintenance or any other purpose. Removal of underground lawn sprinkling systems may be required at any time by the City. Re-installation and or repair shall be the responsibility of the property owner.
4. All underground lawn irrigation systems require the installation of a cross-connection control assembly meeting **Title 8, 8-1C-1: Cross Connection Control-Containment of the City of Clive Code of Ordinance.**
5. All backflow assemblies must be tested at the time of installation and at a minimum annually thereafter by a registered Iowa certified cross-connection control assembly tester. **All test results shall be provided to the property owner and be sent to:**

6. After the system is installed and is ready for inspection or if you have any questions, please to call 223-6231
7. For the best results, make sure your irrigation system timer is properly set. Timers need to be adjusted according to the season. In a rainy month, change the timer setting to avoid over watering. Making small adjustments can lower your summer water bill while conserving our valuable natural resource.

Call Before You Dig

State law says you must call Iowa One Call at 1-800-292-8989 at least two full business days (not including the day of the call) before you dig in your yard. If you fail to do so, and you damage utility lines, you will be charged for repairs. The locating service is free.
