FEE: \$75 per team

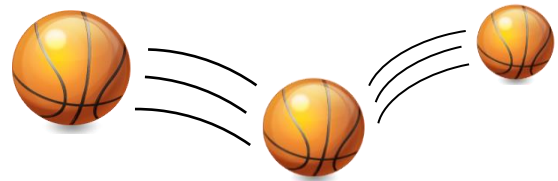
DATE: Saturday, March 4

DIVISIONS: BOYS and GIRLS

GRADES: 4th Grade and Younger, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th–12th



Scheduling brackets will be completed on Tuesday, February 28. The Recreation Department will mail brackets to teams informing them of their schedule. The Clive Recreation Department has the right to change the format of the tournament.

ROSTER: Only five players allowed per roster. To enter a team, the coach/captain must pay the registration fee and have the entry form completed. Players can only play on one team and must be listed on the entry form.

AGE: Participant must be the required age by the day of the tournament.

UNIFORMS: Teams must have matching colored jerseys or shirts. Numbers on the jersey or shirt are recommended.

T-SHIRTS: Each participant will receive a tournament T-shirt on the day of competition. Please make sure the T-shirt sizes are listed on the completed entry form.

CONCESSIONS: A small concession stand will be available.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Each team is required to provide one scorekeeper or timer during their scheduled games. Referees will be provided. Please have your scorekeeper and timer ready to go to stay on schedule.
2. Teams are guaranteed three or more games. All teams will play in a pool to be seeded into a single elimination bracket. Seeding will be determined in the following order: best record, head-to-head, least amount of points given up, most points scored, and finally we will flip a coin.
3. No requests will be made as far as times. Teams must be able to play throughout the day.
4. Games will be played until one team scores 15 points or more. If no team has scored 15 points after 15 minutes of play, the team with the lead will be declared the winner. Championship games will be played to 15 points with a 15-minute time limit (Teams must win by two in the Championship Games).
5. A standard field goal is worth one point; two points will be awarded for baskets made from behind the "take-back" line.
6. Each team is allowed one time out per game (one minute in length). Clock will stop for timeouts and for injuries.
7. Game time is forfeit time.
8. Boys grades 9-12 will use regulation ball. All other divisions will use youth/women's basketball (28.5). Baskets are 10'.
9. Teams will flip a coin to determine first possession. Jump balls will be alternating possessions.
10. The ball must be taken back on each change of possession (defensive rebound, made basket, air ball, stolen ball or turnover).
11. "Taking back" means that both feet of the ball handler are behind the check line. Failure to do so will result in a loss of possession.
12. The opposing team must check in the ball after a made basket or dead-ball situation. Once the ball is "checked" the ball is live, the player can shoot, dribble or pass.
13. Game balls will be provided.
14. Awards will be given to the top two teams in each division.
15. All games must start and finish with at least two players.
16. Player fouls out of the game with five fouls. **When a team has 10 fouls during the game, each additional foul (foul #11) will result in the opposing team receiving one point.**
17. Technical fouls will count as 2 points for the opposing team.
18. Substitution can only be made on check-ins and officials are to be notified.
19. If a player scores and is fouled, that team will retain possession and the basket will count.
20. All games will have officials. Please be considerate.
21. If a player is fouled while shooting and misses the basket, the offensive team will retain possession and must check the ball in.
22. Make sure game scores are correct.
23. Any player/team involved in fighting or continuous misconduct will be disqualified from the tournament. That includes abusive behavior, flagrant fouls or rough play. Any players, fans, and coaches that get dismissed from the tournament – must leave the gym for the remainder of the day.
24. Teams will be notified of their first game no later than Tuesday, March 29th (at the end of the day).
