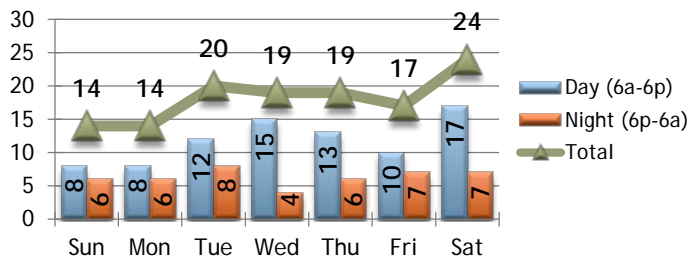


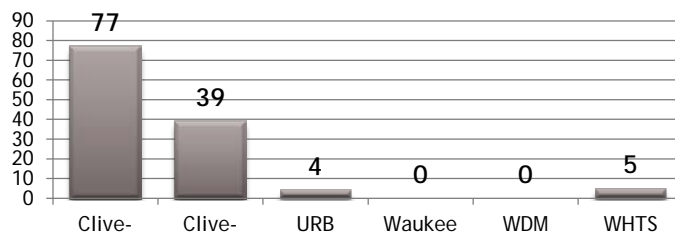

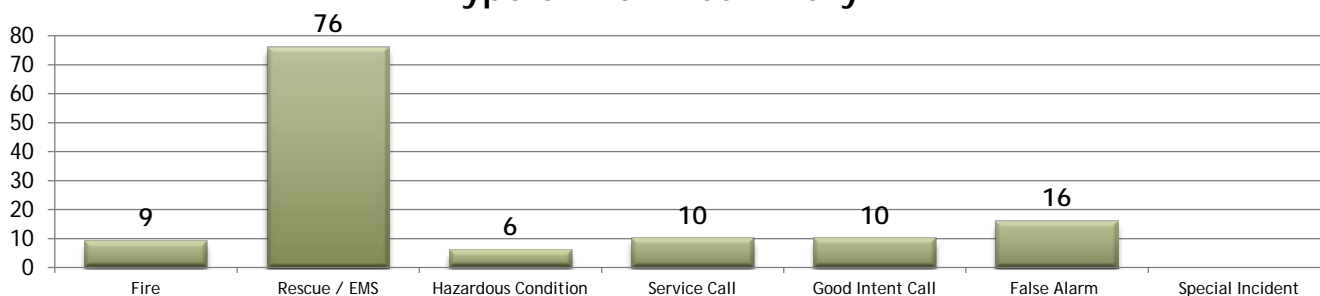
Incidents by Day of Week



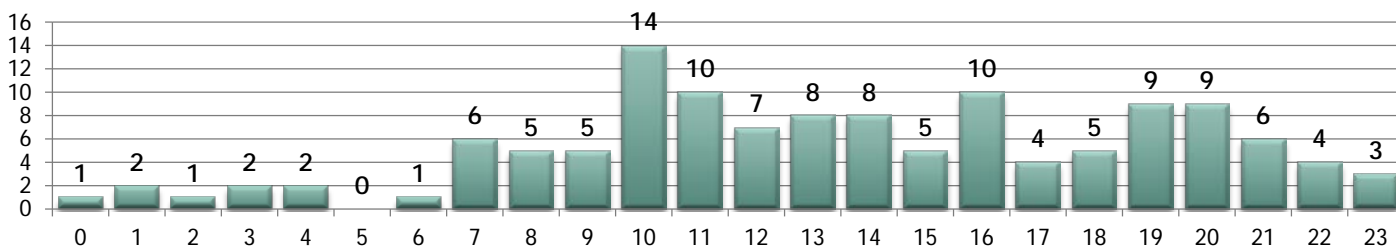
Incidents by District



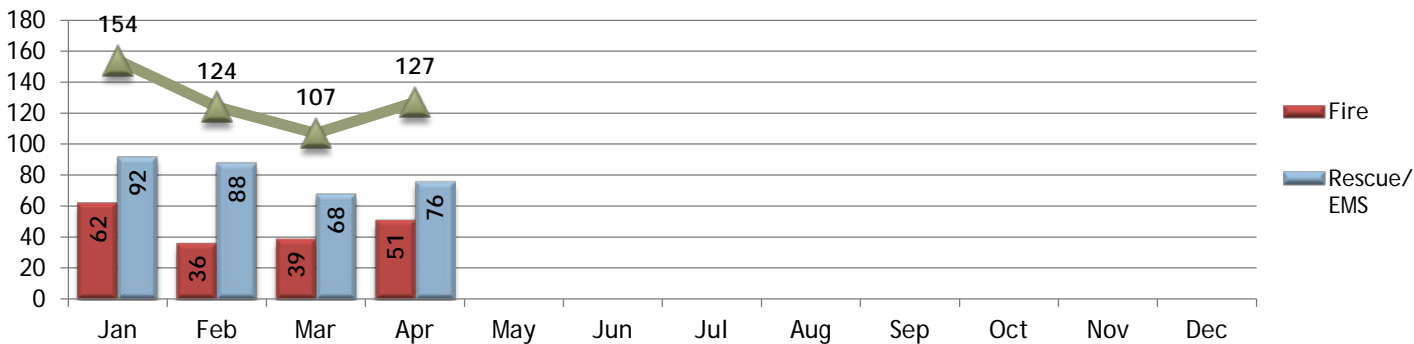
Type of Alarm Summary



Count of Incidents by Alarm Hour



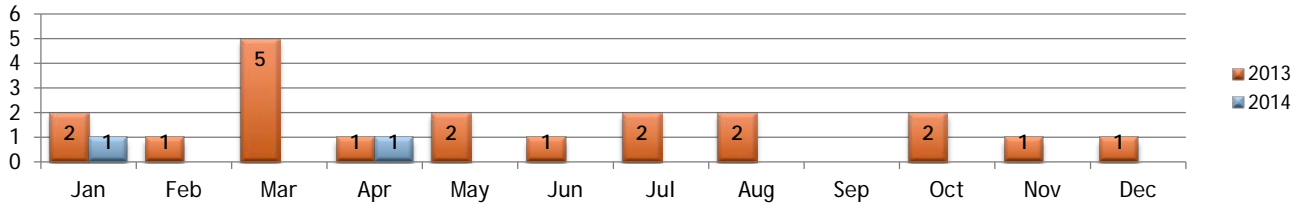

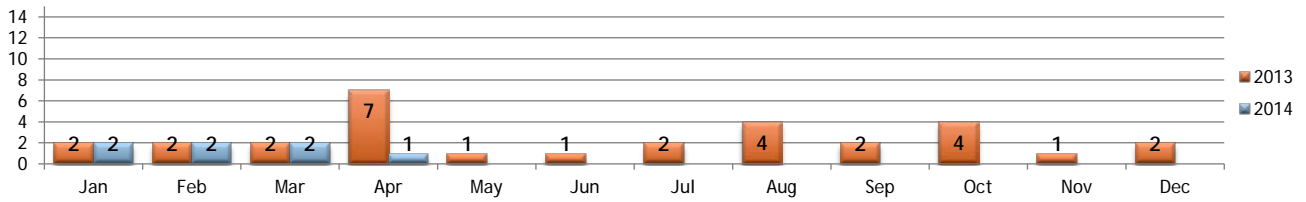

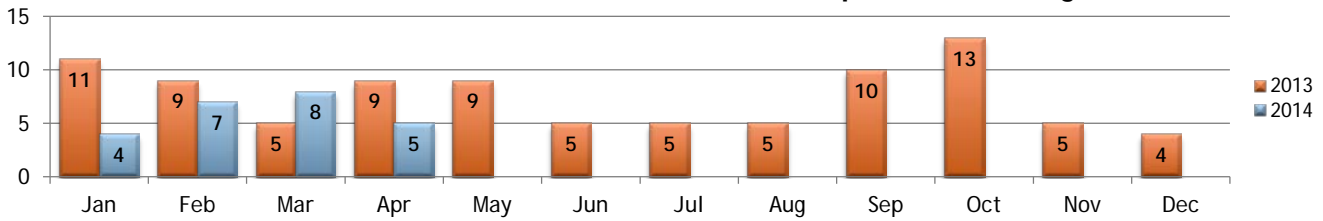

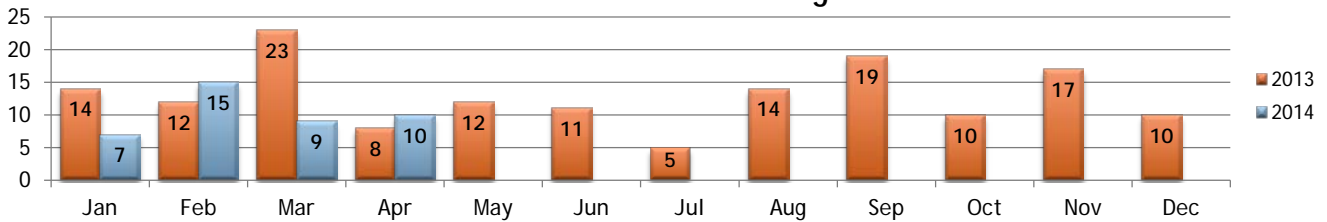

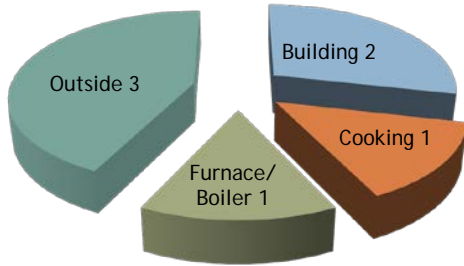

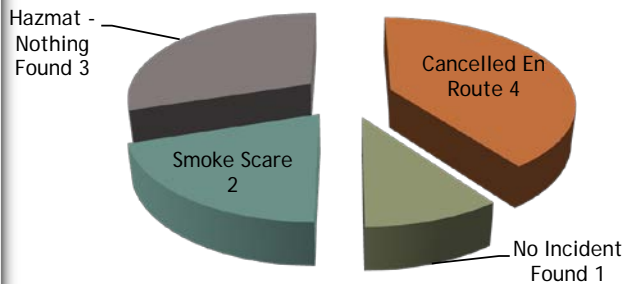

Public Education/Services/Events:

- Smoke Alarm Saturdays - Clive firefighters began installations on Saturdays in November '13 of donated dual-sensing smoke alarms as part of the State Fire Marshal's statewide campaign to install smoke alarms in every Iowa child's home. At the end of April '14, on-duty crews have provided and installed 41 new smoke alarms and replaced 28 batteries in Clive resident's homes.
