Please check the zone and week(s) that you are available and would like to participate in this program. Only one hunter will be allowed to participate each week in each zone. If more than one hunter applies for a certain week, the Parks Manager will establish a lottery drawing to designate the approved hunter. The results of the drawing are final and not subject to appeal. Hunters may place their stand on the day before their assigned week and must remove their stand by the day following their approved week. Any stands left overnight are the responsibility of the hunter. All hunters will be required to meet with the City’s Deer Hunter Coordinator (Joel Pasco) prior to participating in this program and each hunter will be required to post a “Deer Management in Progress” flag (supplied by the City) as they enter or leave the deer management zone. Hunters may harvest up to three deer each day. All hunters must remove 1½ – 2” off of the tip of one ear of all does harvested in the City of Clive. There will be no bucks harvested except for the one buck incentive tag that may be awarded each year.

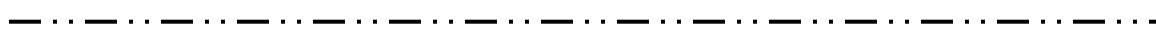
Applications for Clive DMZ permits must be received a minimum of two weeks prior to the dates requested by the applicant.
